

Promotion Name: CW Members Badge Draw Promotions Permit

NSW Permit Number: LTPS/17/13520

Promotional Period

1. "CW Members Badge Draw Promotion" ("Badge Draw") commences on **28/04/2017** and ends **27/04/2018**.

Entry Requirements

1. To be eligible to enter, each entrant must be over 18 and a financial member of "Willoughby Legion Ex Services Club" (Club Willoughby) ("CW").
2. Provisional memberships and temporary memberships are not eligible for entry
3. The promotion commences at 6.30pm and closes at 9pm every Friday evening when CW is open for trade.
4. All eligible entrants must be on the premises of CW to claim their prize.

Prizes & Winning

1. The Badge Draw starts at \$600 and will jackpot by \$200 every week up to a maximum of \$2000 if the badge draw is not won.
2. A computer generated random selector will be used to draw a membership number from the current financial CW membership listing
3. The Badge Draw will be conducted on **Fridays at 6.30 pm, 7.30 pm, & 8.30 pm**
4. The holder of the membership number drawn will have four (4) minutes to claim their prize. They must present their membership card to claim the prize.
5. If the 6.30 pm draw prize is unclaimed, a further draw is conducted at 7.30 pm. etc.
6. If the Jackpot is won in either of the 6.30 pm, 7.30 pm, or 8.30 pm badge draws, then no further badge draws or consolation badge draws will take place that evening following the winning draw.
7. If all 3 draws have taken place without being won, a Minor Consolation Members Badge Draw will take place within 15 minutes of the 8.30 pm Badge Draw taking place.
 - To enter this Minor Consolation Draw, Members on the premises will have 4 minutes to show their membership card and claim their consolation badge draw ticket from the announcer
 - These tickets are then to be filled out by the member and then placed in the barrel/ box
 - 1 x lucky member will be drawn out of the consolation members badge draw barrel. A \$100 cash prize will be issued to the winner
8. Once the Badge Draw reaches the maximum \$2000, and if not won in either of the 6.30 pm, 7.30 pm, and 8.30 pm Badge Draws, it will remain at \$2000 for two (2) additional weeks.
9. If the \$2000 Badge draw is won at any time prior to week 3 at 8.30pm (refer point 10 below), no further badge draws or consolation badge draws will take place on that evening. This will then cause the Badge draw to reset at \$600 the following week.
10. If after three (3) consecutive weeks, the \$2000 Badge Draw has not been won, a Members Charity Consolation Badge Draw will take place on the third (3rd) week after the 8.30 pm badge draw.
 - Entry conditions for this Members Charity Consolation Badge Draw is the same as the entry conditions for the Minor Consolation Badge Draw (refer point 7 above).
11. The prize for the Members Charity Consolation Badge Draw of \$2000 will be dispersed in the following ways:
 - \$1000 will be donated to the Kolling Foundation (registered charity and fundraiser for RNSH Paediatric Department)
 - The remaining \$1000 will be awarded to 10 winners of \$100 each who are current financial members and present at the time of the draw

12. Times may vary slightly from time to time by up to 10 minutes due to live entertainment or other operational matters on the night.
13. Members must use their own membership cards. Cards cannot be used by proxy.
14. All prizes must be claimed within a stipulated timeframe or the default four (4) minutes.
15. No cash prizes can be awarded after 10 pm.
16. Prize winners are advised that Tax implications may arise from their prize winnings and they should seek independent financial advice prior to the acceptance of the prize.
17. Willoughby Legion Ex Services Club (CW) is the promoter. The promoter reserves the right to refuse to allow a winner to take part in any or all aspects of the prize, if the promoter determines, in their absolute discretion, that a winner is not in the mental or physical condition necessary to be able to safely participate in the prize.
18. CW reserves the right to cancel or change the prizes offered under this promotion if there are any changes to the law which would render the promotion or any prizes offered under the promotion unlawful.

NOTE: Immediate Family is defined as; spouse, de facto partner, child, parent, grandparent, grandchild, sibling, or a child, parent, grandparent, grandchild or sibling of the employee's spouse or de facto partner.
22. Participation in the Badge Draw by a patron confirms acceptance of the terms and conditions of the Promotion and the Club's Rules and By-Laws in force from time to time.
23. Should a prize winner consent to having his/her photograph taken, that selected prize winner consents to having his/her name and photograph published in any form of media and agrees to participate in any reasonable promotion requested by CW.

If for any reason this Badge Draw is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process.
25. All entries become the property of the Promoter and may be entered into a database. The promoter may use the entrants' names, addresses and telephone numbers for future promotional, marketing and publicity purposes in any media worldwide without notice and without any fee being paid unless otherwise advised by the entrant.
26. In the event that for any reason whatsoever a winner does not take the prize by the time stipulated (4 minutes) by the promoter then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the winner.
