

WILLOUGHBY LEGION EX-SERVICES CLUB LTD (Club Willoughby)– MEMBERS BADGE DRAW JACKPOT

TERMS & CONDITIONS The members Jackpot Draws consists of two opportunities to win a prize every Friday, the “**Members Badge Draw Jackpot Prize**” & the “**Badge Draw Bonus.**” This promotion is an ongoing club promotion.

1. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- a) Directors, Management, Staff & Contractors of Club Willoughby are ineligible to enter.
- b) Open to all financial members of Club Willoughby over the age of eighteen (18) years who are not suspended or cited from the venue.
- c) In unforeseen circumstances management have the right to cancel or postpone the cash draws at any time.
- d) To claim any prize, members must produce their membership card as proof of current membership and/or one other form of valid identification. Valid ID includes Driver’s License, Proof of Age Card & Pensioner Card.
- e) All members financial as per Club Willoughby membership system at 6pm on the Friday of the draw will be eligible for the draws.
- f) If proposed the prize money of \$2,000 to the prize winner can be paid by cash or EFT if the winner so requests. If EFT payment method is chosen, this will be completed within seventy two (72) hours of the draw.

2. BADGE DRAW TERMS & CONDITIONS

- a) The badge draw starts at \$200 and will jackpot by \$200 each Friday up to a maximum of \$2000 if the Badge Draw is not won.
- b) The draw will be conducted on Friday’s at 6.30pm, 7.30pm & 8.30pm. The Club’s premises, as determined by the Club in its’ discretion and comprise all areas within the main club building (excluding function rooms if in use for a private event at the time of the draws). The Club’s carpark does not form part of the Club’s premises for the purpose of the Club’s promotion.
- c) When the Badge Draw prize has reached \$2,000 and is not won it will remain at \$2,000 for two (2) additional weeks.
- d) If the \$2,000 Badge Draw at any time prior to week 3 is won, no further badge draws will take place on that evening. This will then cause the Badge Draw to reset at \$200 the following week. A Minor Consolation Badge Draw will take place on the third (3rd) week after the 8.30pm badge draw.
- e) The member must be on site when the prize is drawn and claim the prize within four (4) minutes. If the prize is not claimed within four (4) minutes another entry is drawn. There will continue to be draws until the prize is won.
- f) The Minor Badge Draw prize winner is selected by the promotional staff member drawing a ticket from the Members Badge Draw barrel or box.

3. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL CLUB PROMOTIONS

- a) The Club’s premises are as determined by the Club in its discretion and comprise all areas within the main club building (excluding function rooms if in use for a private event at the time of the draws). The Club’s car parks does not form part of the Club’s premises for the purposes of Club promotions.
- b) The Club’s promotional stand (for announcements of all draws) is determined by the Club in its discretion at the time of the draw.
- c) The Club may require a winner to sign a legal acknowledgment, release and receipt in conformity with these conditions and in a form reasonably required by the Club, in order to be paid a prize.
- d) The Club in its reasonable discretion may (but is not obliged to) cancel, suspend, terminate, modify or adjourn the promotion or any or all draws or any or all processes for the selection of any winner, where circumstances unexpected by the Club arise in relation to the promotion or a draw. Unexpected circumstances could include (but are not limited to) technical difficulties, power outages, infection by computer virus, computer bug, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or errors, and any other unexpected circumstance beyond the reasonable control of the Club which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct as planned of the promotion. The Club’s rights are subject to any direction given under any relevant legislation or in connection with any permit under which the promotion is conducted.

- e) The Club's decisions in relation to the promotion may be made by the Club Manager or his delegate or delegates from time to time (who may but need not be a Club executive), including decisions in relation to the appointment of a judge or judges in relation to the promotion or a particular draw or draws. The Club Manager also may (but is not obliged to) appoint one or more scrutineers for a draw or all draws. Decisions by the Club Manager, are subject to any countermanding decision by any such delegate or judge, are final. No such decision requires any consultation. No correspondence will be entered into, in relation to any such decision.
- f) Members wishing to be sure of entry should seek to complete transactions and to initiate ticket printing early, to reduce the risk of being excluded because of any shortage of service points or because of delay or crowding.
- g) The Club is not responsible for, and is not obliged to delay a draw or a process of selecting a winner because of any delay or impediment in connection with the admission of members or in the completion of entries to the promotion or in seeking to attend any draw or to attend the process of selecting a winner.
- h) Further, the Club is not responsible for members being located in areas within the Club's premises in which PA announcements are not able to be heard, nor for the audible integrity of those announcements.
- i) A prize will not be awarded or paid where in the Club's reasonable opinion it arises as a result of a machine or other technical malfunction.
- j) The Club has no liability for acting on or promulgating any incorrect or inaccurate information, due to any error to any equipment or programming associated with or utilised in the promotion or any technical error or error by any third party.
- k) Prizes are strictly not transferable or negotiable.
- l) If the Club in good faith awards or pays a prize to someone appearing to the Club to be the prize winner, then to the maximum extent permitted by law that award or payment fully discharges the Club from all liability to the actual prize winner in relation to that prize.
- m) Tax and financial implications may arise from winning a prize and winners should seek independent tax and financial advice before accepting. The Club is not responsible for any such advice.
- n) No member is required to participate. Participation in the promotion is solely at the option of individual members. Members should not participate unless they are satisfied that they completely understand the way in which the promotion operates and these conditions.
- o) These conditions cannot be varied for an individual member.
- p) The Club determines the designated clock from which draws are timed.
